Last year, we were pleased to see a real resurgeance of classic Drapes with the hardworking Blockout lining behind. It really does do THE best job - not only thermally for Summer and the cooler months but blocking out light for Bedrooms and stopping those draughts as well.

Don't get me wrong, Blinds certainly do still have their places and are great in areas where you don't wish to obstruct a lovely view or don't have the space to 'stack' a Curtain when it's open. I LOVE Roman Blinds – they can really tell a story by using a fabric with a real pop to work as a piece of Artwork or have them blend into their surrounds using textures and simple tones. I also do Sheer Roman Blinds, which have such a lovely soft line to them and can help with privacy as well. They are also great for smaller windows or where you want an actual fabric rather than the hardworking UV Screen Roller Blinds. They all have their place, if you are unsure as to what will work in your home, give me a call and I'll come and show you the options available.

We are seeing SO much blue coming through with forecasting which is great. It's a calming colour of a million degrees/tones/strengths – something for everyone.
